# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Q: How long will the IMPACT Campaign be?

A: Two years

#### Q: What happens to the Blueprint Campaign

A: The Blueprint will be sunset on September 11, 2022

# Q: What happens with the income generated by the Blueprint Campaign?

A: All funds that were/are given to the Blueprint Campaign have been and are being used on building related expenses.

#### Q: Does this take the place of tithe and offering?

A: No, this does not replace your regular tithes and offerings (T&O) but would be above and beyond your regular T&O. So if you typically give 500 per month for T&O, and you pledged 250 per month for the campaign then you would be giving 750 each month.

#### Q: How does the Spiritual Journey work?

A: The Spiritual Journey is a time for fasting and praying for ourselves as individuals, and for the church, as we step out in faith on this journey to IMPACT the Community.

#### Q: When do I make my commitment?

A: Because this is not an act that can be taken lightly, we are allowing time to seek God. We will be asking that you make your commitment on Sunday, October 9, 2022.

#### Q: What happens if I am not able to keep my commitment?

A: We strongly encourage you to stretch but also do so with wisdom. However, we understand things happen beyond our control and as such there is no penalty to the individual, but that amount would then fall on the church to replace which could become detrimental to the campaign if too many people can't keep their commitments.



# What Can I Do?

Your whole life is a gift from God. All of it, including your time, your talents, your energy, and your resources. What will you do with it? What would you do if you knew God was ready to something amazing with it?

**Pray**: Prayer is the roadmap for the journey we are on together. Gather your family and ask, "What would God have us do?"
